

**PUBLIC NOTICE  
CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FLUSHING  
APPLICATIONS FOR DEFERMENT  
OF 2007 SUMMER TAXES**

The Charter Township of Flushing is currently accepting applications for 2007 Summer Tax Deferments.

The Michigan General Property Tax Act has been amended with Public Act 24 of 2005 to allow certain citizens, including senior citizens, veterans and persons with disabilities, to defer their summer property taxes if they have a **household income below \$35,000.**

To qualify for the deferment under the new qualifying income limit, a resident must meet one or more of the following conditions as defined by the State Income Tax Act:

- Totally and permanently disabled, paraplegic or quadriplegic, and blind person
- Eligible serviceperson, eligible veteran, eligible widow or widower
- 62 years of age or older, including the unmarried surviving spouse of a person who is 62 years of age or older at the time of death.
- Property which is classified or used as agricultural real property, and the gross receipts of agricultural or horticultural operations in the previous year (or the average gross receipts for such operations in the previous three (3) years) is not less than the household income for the preceding calendar year.

The deferment applications may be obtained at the Flushing Township Office, 6524 N. Seymour Road, Flushing, Michigan, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 Noon on Friday, or by calling 810-659-0800. **All deferment applications must be received by the Charter Township of Flushing by Friday, September 14, 2007.**
