THE DIFFERENCE IS .0139 MILLS AND RETURNS OUR AUTHORIZED MILL TO .5000 MILL. THE TOWNSHIP IS AUTHORIZED TO LEVY 1.0400 MILLS.

THE TOWNSHIP PROPOSES TO LEVY .8064 MILLS ON THE AUTHORIZED .9085 MILLS APPROVED FOR POLICE OPERATIONS. There is a Police Millage Renewal coming up in November 8, 2011. It was felt the millage renewal is a very sensitive issue. Per the Treasurer, in the 2013 Budget, it will reflect a \$240,000 reduction in what the Police Millage was in 2007-2008. At the same 3.114 Mills, by the values of home decreasing, it generates \$240,000.00 less to run a Police Department today than when it did when the former Board ask for a 1 Mill increase.

The Clerk stated she had received a lot of calls wanting information as to how and what the millage would cover. It was ask if a Town Hall Meeting could be held to answer some of the questions. It was also recommended to post an informational article on the Web or to have the Supervisor, Clerk, and Treasurer gather facts and have the Flint Journal Reporter place an article in the newspaper.

2. SUPERVISOR PECK'S COMMENTS:

- a. <u>Updates of Road Repairs:</u>
 - 1. <u>Gillette Road</u> and <u>Stanley Road</u> has recently been repaired; next year (2012) the roads will be chip and sealed.
 - 2. <u>Carpenter Road</u> has been completed repaired between McKinley Road and Cedardale Drive; calls have been received by the Township regarding speeders on the new road.
 - 3. <u>Coldwater Road</u> will soon be repaired between Seymour Road and M-13 and should be completed by the end of September. A culvert has been replaced on Coldwater Road a short distance from Turner Road; the ditching (on Coldwater Road) has to be completed before the repair work can be done. Next year the road will be chip and sealed.
- b. <u>Carpenter Road (between Deland Road and Elms Road):</u> something will have to be done next year on Carpenter Road in front of the Flushing Middle

- School; the Supervisor will be looking into grants, through the school system, and other resources to see if the township can get help with the repair work.
- c. <u>Basic Disaster Plan:</u> the Supervisor will be attending six (6) classes in order to get updated with the Disaster Plan; the Clerk, Treasurer, and Police Chief will also be taking some of the classes in the next few months in order to be up to date.
- d. Police Department Contracts:
 - 1. the township was not able to get a contract with the Patrolmen so it will be going to Arbitration.
 - 2. Negotiations are ongoing with Sgt Brian Fairchild with a new three (3) year proposal.
 - 3. Negotiations are ongoing with the Police Chief for a new two (2) year proposal.
 - 4. Letters have been sent to the Teamsters Union to start negotiations with the office personnel starting in November.
- e. <u>Hazardous Waste Day</u>: will be held on Saturday, October 8, 2011 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for the public to drop off such items as electronics, paints, and hazardous materials. Stay tune for more details.
